- ◆ Two-thirds of CSU graduates and one-third of UC graduates begin their college years at a community college – and, upon transferring to either four-year institution, obtain GPAs equal to, or better than, “native” UC or CSU students.
- ◆ In 2004, UC officials indicated that 25% of UC-eligible high school graduates had at least one community college course on their transcript.
